NOTICE TO BIDDERS

NOTICE is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter called the "Owner") for:

Sealed Bids for the above named Contract, which comprises the cleaning, dewatering, bypass pumping, blockage removal, CCTV, rehabilitation, cured in place pipe (CIPP) lining, guniting, and replacement of designated sections of the Owner's existing combined sanitary/storm sewer system, will be received at the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority Main Conference Room, 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey 07305 on **May 10, 2017 at 2:00 pm** prevailing time, at which time they will be publicly unsealed and the contents publicly announced.

The work includes furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the work as shown on the Drawings and as described in the Specifications. The work comprises the cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining of approximately 25,650 linear feet of combined sewer, the guniting of approximately 3,000 linear feet of combined sewer, and the replacement of approximately 10,400 linear feet of combined sewer throughout the City of Jersey City, including associated sewer cleaning, internal television inspection, maintenance of sewage flows, traffic control, utility relocation, and other appurtenant work. The existing combined sewers in this project consist of 12-inch through 96-inch diameter pipe. The existing pipe materials include VCP, PVC, RCP, DIP, Brick, and unreinforced concrete pipe. The work also includes manhole rehabilitation and replacement, catch basin replacement, and water main and other utility infrastructure relocation as needed and directed. The work shall be completed within 480 calendar days of the Contractor's receipt of written Notice to Proceed.

Contract Documents and Plans for the proposed work prepared by Kevin Wynn, P.E., Mott MacDonald may be examined at the office of said Engineer at 111 Wood Avenue South, Iselin, New Jersey 08830 and at the office of the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey, during business hours (9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.) and may be obtained at the offices of the JCMUA upon payment of \$150.00 per set check or money order only. An electronic copy will be made available to Bidders at no charge. You must register with the JCMUA and you will be directed to an FTP site maintained by Mott MacDonald. You must register with the JCMUA first in order to be eligible to receive a password. The JCMUA and Mott

MacDonald will insure that the site works, however, the JCMUA and Mott MacDonald will not be responsible if the Bidder can not download the document. **NO BIDS MAY BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY!** Proposals in the contract Documents must be enclosed in sealed envelopes bearing the name and address of the Bidder and the name of the work on the outside addressed to the Purchasing Agent, JCMUA. Each proposal must be submitted in writing on the proposed pages furnished in the Contract Documents. This entire document must be submitted at the time of bid. No bids will be received after the date and time specified and no Bids shall be received by mail.

BIDDER MUST SUPPLY ONE (1) ORIGINAL AND ONE (1) COPY OF THE BID, INCLUDING THE BID SPECIFICATIONS. IN ADDITION, BIDDER MUST SUPPLY ONE CD ROM VERSION IN PDF FORMAT. BIDDER DOES NOT HAVE TO INCLUDE A COPY OF THE PLANS WITH ITS BID SUBMITTAL. HOWEVER, IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED BY THE BIDDER THAT THE PLANS CONSTITUTE AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE BID SPECIFICATIONS AND WILL BE CONSIDERED AS PART OF THE BIDDER'S BID SUBMITTAL.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a bid bond in the amount of ten (10%) percent of the Bid, but not more than \$20,000.00, cashier's check or certified check made payable to the JCMUA. Each Bid must be accompanied by a certificate of experience and certificate of equipment.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a certificate of Consent of Surety from a Bonding Company licensed to do business in the State of New Jersey and named in the current list of Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds," U.S. Treasury Department, guaranteeing that if the proposal of the bidder be accepted they will furnish the bond set forth in Paragraph One of the General Conditions of the Contract and the acceptance of the Bid will be contingent upon the fulfillment of this requirement.

The JCMUA shall award the Contract or reject all bids within 60 days of bid opening except that the bids of any bidders, who consent thereto may, at the request of the JCMUA, are held for considerations for such longer consideration as may be agreed consistent with applicable law.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority's Main Conference Room, 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey 07305 on **April 12, 2017, at 10:30 am**, prevailing time. Contractors are strongly encouraged to attend the Pre-Bid Conference.

Bidders and their sub-contractors of any tier must comply with all applicable provisions of the Public Works Contractors registration Act P.L. 1999, c. 238 (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48) and the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25).

During the performance of this Contract, the Contractor agrees to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 Affirmative Action of the State of New Jersey, all requirements of the State of New Jersey Worker Health and Safety Act (N.J.A.C. 12:110 et seq.) as amended with regard to worker and jobsite safety.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a performance Bond in the full amount of Contract price.

The Authority will evaluate Bids and any award will be made to the lowest, responsive, responsible Bidder in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11.

The Contract is expected to be funded in part with the funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust, nor any of their departments, agencies, or employees is, or will be, a party to the Contract or any lower tier contract or subcontract. The Contract or Subcontract will be subject to regulations contained in N.J.A.C. 7:22-3.1 et seq., 4.1 et seq., 5.1 et seq., 9.1 et seq. and 10 et seq., Local Public Contract Laws, Department of Labor Current Wage Rate Determination, Prevailing Wage Act, Contract Work Hours and Safety Standard Act, Copland Act, Davis Bacon Act, Buy American Clause, Debarment and Suspension, and Socially and Economically Disadvantaged (SED) (N.J.A.C. 7:22-9).
