TRANSPORTATION OF GRIT & SCREENINGS

Sealed bids for TRANSPORT AND DISPOSAL OF GRIT & SCREENINGS will be received by the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority at the offices of the Authority, located at 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey on **August 2, 2016 at 2:00 P.M.** prevailing time, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

The contract involves the continuous provision of four (4) 20 cubic yard roll-off containers, for the collection of grit and screenings generated at the Authority's at East Side and West Side Pump Stations, transport of the containers for disposal in accordance with Hudson County District Solid Waste Management Plan. The grit and screenings material is considered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to be a non-hazardous solid waste as a result of a waste classification determination based on sampling results for the material. Work shall be bid in one, two, three and five-year contract periods. Each bidder is required as part of the bid to submit copies of all licenses and permits required to perform the type of work described herein. The Contractor shall be required to provide evidence with their bid of their ability to secure the necessary environmental/impairment liability insurance as well as required bonds and insurances. The successful bidder shall be responsible for securing all permits as may be required for performance of the work.

A copy of the Contract Specifications is on file at the office of the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, Jersey City, New Jersey. The Contract Drawings and Specifications may be examined or pick-up between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Bids may be submitted in person, or may be sent by United States Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested, or may be sent by private courier service to the Authority's Purchasing Agent no later than **2:00 PM, prevailing time on August 2, 2016.** Bids will have the date and time stamped upon receipt. Bidder is solely responsible for the timely delivery of the bid and no bids may be submitted electronically. Any Bid received after the date and term specified will be returned, unopened to the bidder, if requested in writing by potential bidders. The Authority will send a bid packet through private courier service to such bidders but the Authority relinquishes any responsibility to insure that bid packets are received by bidders. The cost of sending the Bid Specification shall be the sole responsibility of the Bidder. Bidders must submit one original and one copy of their bid. In addition, Bidders must provide one CD ROM version of their bids in PDF format. Bids must be made upon the blank forms provided.

A Bid must be accompanied by a Surety's Consent and either a bid bond or Certified check for

not less than ten (10%) percent of the amount of the bid or \$20,000.00 maximum, whichever is the lesser. Certified checks shall be made payable to Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority. The Surety shall be bound to furnish a Performance Bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent of the Contract Price.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements concerning equal employment opportunity and affirmative action, **N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq.** and **N.J.A.C. 17:27-1 et seq.**

Accompanying the bid of corporation or a partnership, there shall be submitted a statement setting forth the name and address of all stockholders in the corporation or partnership who own 10% or more of its stock, of any class; or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10% or greater interest therein, as the case may be.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty days after the date of the opening of bids without the written consent of the Authority.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, as well as the right to waive all informalities in awarding a contract deemed to be in the best interest of the Authority.

Mutually agreed upon extensions of time may be made, if necessary, and in accordance with law.
