Separate sealed proposals will be received by The Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, Administration Building in the Anthony J. Fiola Memorial Conference Room, 555 Route #440, Jersey City, New Jersey, on **November 10, 2016 at 2:00 p.m.** prevailing time for the performance of the following service:

- 1. Providing Disposable Netting Bags and Associated Hardware for CSO Netting Facilities**

This project consists of providing and delivery of disposable nets for CSO netting facilities on an as needed basis.

At that time and place, the sealed bids will be opened publicly, and read aloud for consideration by the Authority (Owner).

Bids may be submitted in person, or may be sent by United States Certified Mail Return Requested, or may be sent by Private Courier Service to the Authorities Purchasing Agent no later than 2:00 PM, prevailing time on **November 10, 2016**. Bid proposals will have the date and time stamped upon receipt. Bidders are solely responsible for the timely delivery of the Bid Proposal and no bids shall be considered that are presented after the public call for receiving Bids. Bid Proposals received after the date and time specified will be returned, unopened to the Bidder, if requested in writing. The Authority will send a Bid packet through private courier service to such Bidders but the Authority relinquishes any responsibility to insure that Bid packets are received by Bidders. The Authority assumes responsibility only for sending the Bid packets to the courier service and not for proper and timely delivery of such packets. The cost of sending the Bid packet shall be the sole responsibility of the Bidder. Bids must be submitted to the Authority by the parties bidding or their agents, at the place and time designated and none will be accepted thereafter. Contract Drawings and Specifications can be picked up by Bidders at the JCMUA, Purchasing Department, 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey 07305.

BIDDER MUST SUPPLY ONE (1) ORIGINAL AND ONE (1) COPY OF THE BID. IN ADDITION, BIDDER MUST SUPPLY ONE CD ROM VERSION IN PDF FORMAT.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or Certified Check for not less than ten (10%) percent of the amount for the bid or \$20,000.00 maximum, whichever is the lesser. Certified Checks shall be made payable to the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority.

A PERFORMANCE BOND IS NOT REQUIRED FOR THIS CONTRACT. BIDDERS MUST COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF N.J.S.A.: 10:5-31 ET SEQ. AND N.J.A.C. 17:27 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

Accompanying the bid of a corporation or a partnership, there shall be submitted a statement setting forth the name and address of all stockholders in the corporation or partnership who own 10% or more of its stock, of any class; or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10% or greater interest therein, as the case may be. If one or more such stockholder(s) or partner(s) is itself a corporation or partnership the stockholders holding 10% or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning a 10% or greater interest in that partnership, as the case may be, shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every non-corporate stockholder and individual partner exceeding the 10% ownership criteria established in the applicable New Jersey Public Laws of 1977, Chapter 8, has been listed. The requirements of P.L. 1977 Chapter 8 N.J.S.A.52:25-24.2 are to apply to all forms if corporations and partnerships including limited partnerships, limited liability corporations, limited liability partnerships and subchapter corporations.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities, or to accept the bid for the Contract which, in its judgment, best serves the interest of the Authority. Bids shall hold firm and remain effective for sixty (60) days from the date of the Bid opening.

Mutually agreed upon extensions of time may be made, if necessary, and in accordance with law.

Bids shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the opening of bids without the written consent of the Authority.
