Sealed bids for the **EASTSIDE AND WESTSIDE PUMPING STATION IMPROVEMENTS-PHASE 1** will be received by the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority in the Anthony J. Fiola Memorial Conference Room, Administration Building, located at 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey on **December 14, 2016 at 2:00pm** prevailing time, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. A Pre-bid Conference will be held on **November 22, 2016 at 10:30am** at the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey. All Bidders are strongly encouraged to attend the Pre-bid Conference which will include a description of the scope of work. Questions will be addressed at that time.

Briefly described, work under this contract includes but is not limited to the construction of Ductwork Replacement, Secondary Stair access to Grit Channel area, concrete repair, painting, Emergency Generator Exhaust Fan Replacement, Surge Valve Controls. Work under this contract involves all labor and equipment for Eastside and Westside Pumping Station Improvements-Phase 1.

The Contractor is responsible to comply with all laws, regulations, OSHA regulations and other applicable requirements. The successful bidder shall be responsible for securing all municipal and county permits as may be required for performance of the work.

All bids shall be presented to the OWNER by the parties bidding, or their agents, at the place and time designated, when called for by the OWNER. No bids will be received prior to the time designated and none will be accepted thereafter. Each proposal must be submitted in writing on the proposal pages furnished in the Contract Documents. The entire document must be submitted at the time of the bid. Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder as found in the N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-6.1.

Contract Documents may be examined at the offices of the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey or at the offices of Mayo, Lynch and Associates, Inc./L+C Design Consultants, PA, One Marine Plaza, North Bergen, New Jersey 07047. An electronic copy will be made available to Bidders at no charge. You must register with the JCMUA and you will be directed to a "Dropbox folder" maintained by Mayo Lynch and Associates, Inc./L&C Design Consultants, PA. money orders for Contract Documents shall be made payable to the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Certificate of Consent of Surety written by a Surety company listed on the Federal Treasury List (Environmental Protection Department Circular 570-Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds) as required by N.J.A.C. 7:22-3.17 and either a bid bond or Certified check for not less than ten (10%) percent of the amount of the bid or \$20,000.00 maximum whichever is the lesser. Certified checks shall be made payable to Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority. The said Surety shall be bound to furnish and deliver to the OWNER Performance and Labor and Material and Maintenance Bonds, each in an amount equal to one hundred percent of the Contract Price.

BIDDER MUST SUPPLY ONE (1) ORIGINAL AND ONE (1) COPY OF THE BID. IN ADDITION, BIDDER MUST SUPPLY ONE CD ROM VERSION IN PDF FORMAT. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO INCLUDE ANY DRAWINGS OR PLANS, ONLY THE SPECIFICATIONS.”

BIDDERS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF N.J.A.C. 10:5-31 Et. seq. AND N.J.A.C. 17:27 Affirmative Action State of New Jersey.

Accompanying the bid of corporation or a partnership, there shall be submitted a statement setting forth the name and address of all stockholders in the corporation or partnership who own 10% or more of its stock, of any class; or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10% or greater interest therein, as the case may be. If one or more such stockholder(s) or partner(s) is itself a corporation or partnership the stockholders holding 10% or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning a 10% or greater interest in that partnership, as the case may be, shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every non-corporate stockholder and individual partner exceeding the 10% ownership criteria established in the applicable New Jersey Public Laws of 1977, Chapter 8, has been listed. The requirements of P.L. 1977 Chapter 8 N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 are applicable to all forms of corporations and partnerships including limited partnerships, limited liability corporations, limited liability partnerships and subchapter S corporations.

Bidders and their sub-contractors of any tier must comply with all applicable provisions of the Public Works Contractors Registration Act, N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 and the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25.

This Contract or subcontract is expected to be funded in part with funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Infrastructure Trust nor any of their departments, agencies or employees is, or will be, a party to this contract or subcontract or any lower tier contract or subcontract. This contract or subcontract is subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-3, 4, 5, 9, and 10. The successful bidder must comply with all the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.1 et. Seq. for the participation of small business enterprises owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (SEDs) and the requirements of the JCMUA Socially and Economically Disadvantaged (SED) Utilization Plan dated April 2012.

No BIDDER may withdraw his Bid within sixty days after the date of the opening of Bids without the written consent of the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority.

Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, as well as the right to waive all informalities in awarding a contract deemed to be in the best interest of the Authority, in accordance with applicable law.

Mutually agreed upon extensions of time may be made, if necessary, and in accordance with law.
