

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE JERSEY CITY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

Separate sealed proposals will be received by The Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, Administration Building in the Anthony J. Fiola Memorial Conference Room, 555 Route #440, Jersey City, New Jersey, on **May 15, 2014 at 2:00 P.M.** prevailing time for the performance of the following service:

1. Providing PVC Gravity Sewer Pipe and Associated Fittings

At that time and place, the sealed bids will be opened publicly, and read aloud for consideration by the Authority (Owner).

The Authority is seeking proposals for Purchase and Delivery for PVC Gravity Sewer Pipe and Associated Fittings.

All bids must be submitted on the form provided with the Specifications, must be accompanied by the complete bid packet, and submitted in a sealed opaque envelope marked clearly on the outside as follows:

“Sealed Bid PVC Gravity Sewer Pipe and Associated Fittings” and addressed to, Purchasing Agent, Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority 555 Route 440, Jersey City, New Jersey 07305.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or certified check for not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid or \$20,000.00 maximum, whichever is the lesser. Certified checks shall be made payable to the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority.

At the time and place, the sealed Bids will be opened publicly, and read aloud for consideration by the Authority. Bids may be submitted in person, or may be sent by United States Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested, or may be sent by Private Courier Service to the Authorities Purchasing Agent no later than **2:00P.M.**, prevailing time on **May 15, 2014**. Bids will have the date and time stamped upon receipt. Bidder is solely responsible for the timely delivery of the Bid and no Bids shall be considered that are presented after the public call for receiving bids. Any Bid received after the date and time specified will be returned, unopened to the Bidder, if requested in writing by potential Bidders. The Authority will send a bid packet through private courier service to such Bidders, but the Authority relinquishes any responsibility to insure that Bid Specifications are received by Bidders. The Authority assumes responsibility only for sending the bid packets to the courier service and not for proper and timely delivery of such packets. The cost of sending the bid specification shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder.

A copy of the Bid Specifications is on file at the office of the Authority, Jersey City, New Jersey. The Bid Specifications, including Contract Drawings, may be examined or picked up between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

BIDDER SHALL INCLUDE ONE (1) ORIGINAL AND ONE (1) COPY OF THE BID PACKAGE AND CD ROM VERSION IN A PDF FORMAT.

A PERFORMANCE BOND IS NOT REQUIRED FOR THIS CONTRACT. BIDDERS MUST COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF N.J.S.A. 10: 5-31 ET SEQ. AND N.J.A.C. 17:27 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

Accompanying the bid of a corporation or a partnership, there shall be submitted a statement setting forth the name and address of all stockholders in the corporation or partnership who own 10% or more of its stock, of any class; or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10% or greater interest therein, as the case may be. If one or more such stockholder(s) or partner(s) is itself a corporation or partnership the stockholders holding 10% or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning a 10% or greater interest in that partnership, as the case may be, shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every non-corporate stockholder and individual partner exceeding the 10% ownership criteria established in the applicable New Jersey Public Laws of 1977, Chapter 8, has been listed. The requirements of P.L. 1977 Chapter 8 N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 are to apply to all forms if corporations and partnerships including limited partnerships, limited liability corporations, limited liability partnerships and subchapter corporations.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities, or to accept the bid for the Contract which, in its judgment, best serves the interest of the Owner. The Contractor's proposal shall hold firm for sixty (60) days.

Mutually agreed upon extensions of time may be made, if necessary, and in accordance with law.

No bids shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the opening of bids without the written consent of the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority subsequent to the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.3.
