Separate sealed proposals will be received by The Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, in the Anthony J. Fiola Memorial Conference Room, Administration Building, 555 Route #440, Jersey City, New Jersey, on **July 12, 2016 at 2:00 p.m.** prevailing time for the performance of the following service:

Bids may be submitted in person, or may be sent by United States Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested, or may be sent by Private Courier Service to the Authorities Purchasing Agent no later than 2:00P.M., prevailing time on **July 12, 2016**. Bid proposals will have the date and time stamped upon receipt. BIDDER is solely responsible for the timely delivery of the Bid proposal and no Bids shall be considered which are presented after the public call for receiving bids. Any Bid Proposal received after the date and time specified will be returned, unopened to the BIDDER, if requested in writing by potential BIDDERS. The OWNER will send a Bid packet through private courier service to such BIDDERS but the OWNER relinquishes any responsibility to insure that Bid packets are received by BIDDERS. The OWNER assumes responsibility only for sending the Bid packets to the courier service and not for proper and timely delivery of such packets. The cost of sending the Bid specification shall be the sole responsibility of the BIDDER. BIDDER SHALL INCLUDE ONE (1) ORIGINAL AND ONE (1) COPY OF THE BID PACKAGE AND CD ROM VERSION IN A PDF FORMAT.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a Consent of Surety and a Bid Bond or Certified Check for not less than ten (10%) percent of the amount for the bid or \$20,000.00 maximum whichever is the lesser. Certified Checks shall be made payable to The Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority. The said surety shall be bound to furnish a Performance Bond in an amount equal to one hundred (100 %) percent of the contract price.

BIDDERS MUST COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENT ON THE NEW JERSEY PREVAILING WAGE ACTS AND REGULATIONS N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 ET SEQ. WITH RESPECT TO CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT TO BE OBSERVED AND MINIMUM WAGE RATES TO BE PAID.

BIDDERS MUST COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF, N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 ET

SEQ. AND N.J.A.C. 17:27 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

Accompanying the Bid of corporation or a partnership, there shall be submitted a statement setting forth the name and address of all stockholders in the corporation or partnership who own 10% or more of its stock, of any class; or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10% or greater interest therein, as the case may be. If one or more such stockholder(s) or partner(s) is itself a corporation or partnership the stockholders holding 10% or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning a 10% or greater interest in that partnership, as the case may be, shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every non-corporate stockholder and individual partner exceeding the 10% ownership criteria established in the applicable New Jersey Public Laws of 1977, Chapter 8, has been listed. The requirements of P.L. 1977 Chapter 8 N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 are to apply to all forms of Corporations and Partnerships including Limited Partnerships, Limited Liability Corporations, Limited Liability Partnerships, and Subchapter Corporations.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informalities, or to accept the Bid for the Contract which, in its judgment, best serves the interests of the OWNER. The BIDDER'S proposal shall hold firm for sixty (60) days.

Mutually agreed upon extensions of time may be made, if necessary, and in accordance with law.

No bids shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the opening of bids without the written consent of The Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority.
