The Authority is seeking Bids for Removal and Disposal of Street Excavation Material from the Authority's Facility.

All Bids must be submitted on the form provided with the Bid Specifications, must be accompanied by the complete Bid packet, and submitted in a sealed, opaque envelope marked clearly on the outside as follows:

Removal and Disposal of Street Debris from Authority's Facility

and addressed to, Purchasing Agent, Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, 555 Route #440, Jersey City, New Jersey 07305.

At that time and place, the sealed Bids will be opened publicly, and read aloud for consideration by the Authority. Bids may be submitted in person, or may be sent by Private Courier Service to the Authority's Purchasing Agent no later than 2:00 PM, prevailing time on April 22, 2014. Bids will have the date and time stamped upon receipt. Bidder is solely responsible for the timely delivery of the Bid and no Bids shall be considered that are presented after the public call for receiving Bids. Any Bid received after the date and time specified will be returned, unopened to the Bidder, if requested in writing by potential Bidders. The Authority will send a Bid Specifications through private courier service to such Bidders, but the Authority relinquishes any responsibility to insure that Bid Specifications are received by Bidders. The cost of sending the Bid Specifications shall be the sole responsibility of the Bidder.

A copy of the Bid Specifications is on file at the office of the Authority, Jersey City, New Jersey. The Bid Specifications, including Contract Drawings, may be examined or pick-up between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid bond or certified check for not less than **10%** of the amount of the Bid or \$20,000.00 maximum, whichever is the lesser. Certified checks shall be made payable to the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority.

BIDDER SHALL INCLUDE ONE (1) ORIGINAL AND TWO (2) COPIES OF THE BID PACKAGE. BIDDER MUST INCLUDE ONE CD ROM VERSION IN PDF FORMAT.

A PERFORMANCE BOND IS NOT REQUIRED FOR THIS CONTRACT. BIDDERS MUST COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF N.J.S.A. 10: 5-31 ET SEQ. AND N.J.A.C. 17:27 AFFIRMATIVE ACTION OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

Accompanying the Bid of a corporation or a partnership, there shall be submitted a statement setting forth the name and address of all stockholders in the corporation or partnership who own 10% or more of its stock, of any class; or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10% or greater interest therein, as the case may be. If one or more such stockholder(s) or partner(s) is itself a corporation or partnership the stockholders holding 10% or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning a 10% or greater interest in that partnership, as the case may be, shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every non-corporate stockholder and individual partner exceeding the 10% ownership criteria established in the applicable New Jersey Public Laws of 1977, Chapter 8, has been listed. The requirements of P.L. 1977 Chapter 8 are to apply to all forms if corporations and partnerships including limited partnerships, limited liability corporations, limited liability partnerships and subchapter corporations.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informalities, or to accept the Bid for the Contract that, in its judgment, best serves the interest of the Authority. The Contractor's Bid shall hold firm for a period of sixty (60) days from the date for the receipt of Bids.

Mutually agreed upon extensions of time may be made, if necessary, and in accordance with law.

No Bids shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the opening of Bids without the written consent of the Authority, subject to the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.3.
