Question #1 - Is Qualification Requirement No. 3 (Diplomate in Port Engineering and Coastal Engineering) a "AND/OR" requirement, or are both Port and Coastal qualifications required

Response: A Respondent must have a diplomate in both coastal <u>and</u> port engineering. However, it does not have to be the same individual.

Question #2 - Will the successful proposer of this RFQ/ RFP be excluded from the detailed design phase of the project?

Response: No.

Question #3 - We assume this project will be FEMA/ HUD funded. Has there been any concept work in the form of HUD application and/ or concept study developed to date? Can we get a copy?

Response: It is not presently anticipated that the project will be funded by FEMA/HUD. Accordingly, no application and/or concept design has been developed that would be filed with these agencies. A determination as to funding for the project will be made at a later date.
